We close for the holidays on **Sunday, 29th March** and reopen for the summer term on **Monday, 13th April**. See you then!

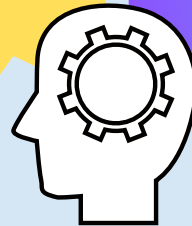

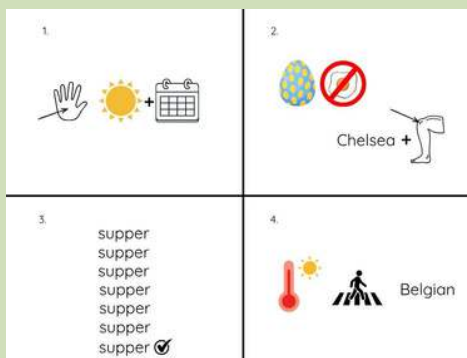


When it comes to remembering things, sometimes the quirkier the technique, the better! These strange methods might be worth a shot as they are proven to be successful!

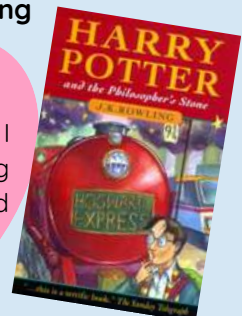
